


# PRIORITIES

- A. Provide organ maintenance
- B. Provide physical expansion of the organ as funds permit
- C. Support music for the choir
- D. Provide scholarships for worthy music students agreeing to give service to the church
- E. Support an annual “social” (dinner or appropriate event for members of the choir)
- F. Support any other Christian oriented mission or charity approved by the Special Trustee Board

# ADMINISTRATION & SUPERVISION

- The Fund shall be supervised and administered by a “Special Trustee Board.”
- The special trustee board shall consist of three (3) members as presented by the Pastor of the church and approved by the congregation or Official Board, whichever is appropriate.

# BANK REGULATION AND GROWTH

- Two accounts
    - Primary – investment only
    - Secondary – interest-bearing account
  - Safe Deposit
  - Funds may be reinvested at a higher interest rate providing the minimum balance remains in the secondary account.

# Expansion

- Additional donations are permitted
- The secondary account may always be expanded, but never reduced.

Fifty percent (50%) or one half of the interest accrued may only be used for the stated purpose of "The Fund."

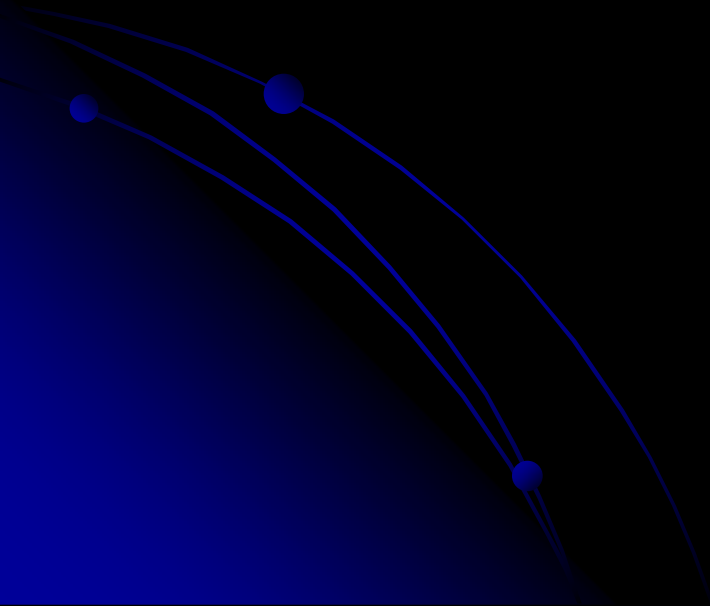
The remaining fifty percent (50%) or one half must remain in the secondary account.

# GROWTH

- Fifty percent (50%) or one half of the interest accrued only may be used for the stated purpose of “The Fund.”
- The remaining fifty percent (50%) or one half must remain in the secondary account.
- The fund Trustee Board, at their discretion, may reinvest at a higher interest rate only if the secondary account is sufficient to remove a portion leaving the required minimum balance.

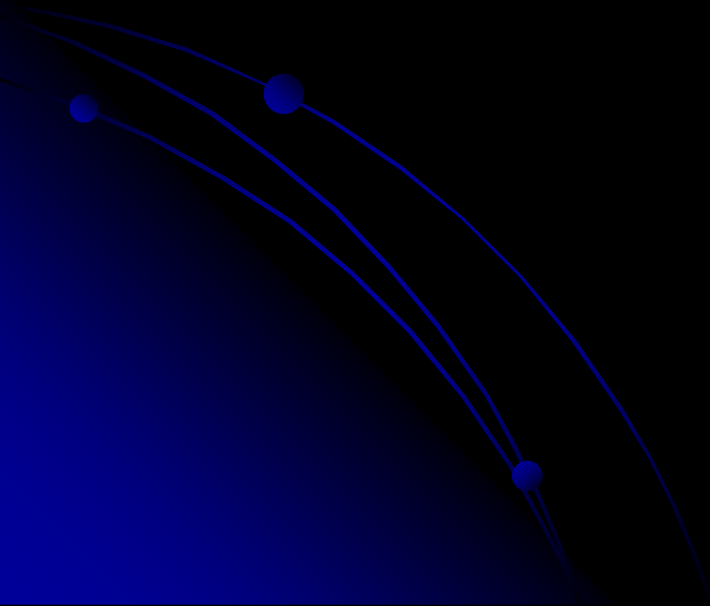
# GROWTH

- “The Fund” or its annuities may not be used as collateral or security for loans or other financial obligations of the church or any of its organizations or auxiliaries




# DISBURSEMENTS

All requests must be in writing and submitted to the special trustee board for consideration before disbursements can be made.

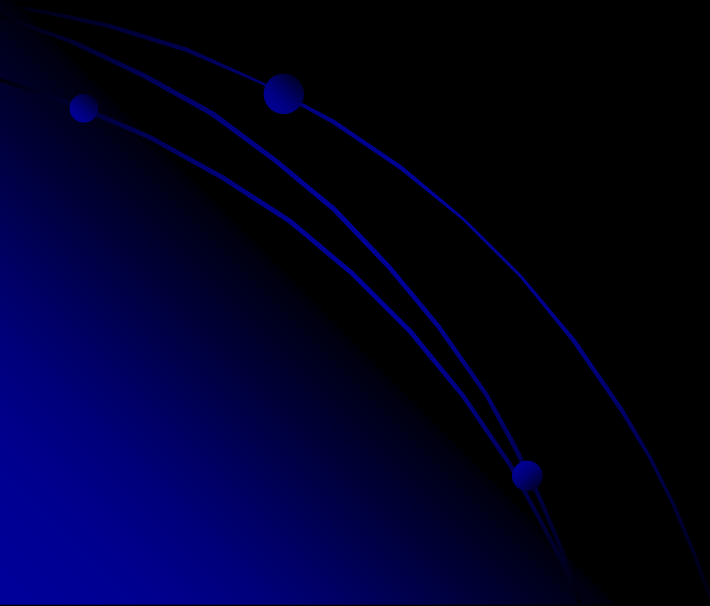

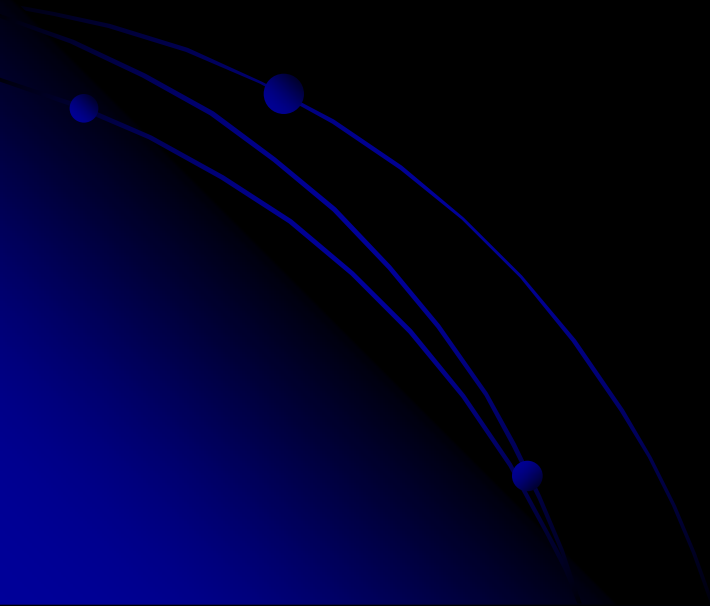

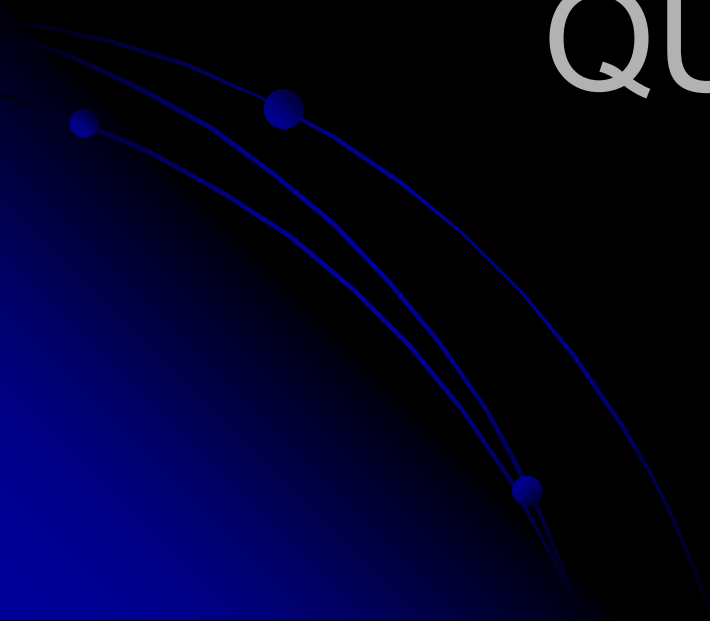
